

That meant 80+ loaves of bread to buy, pack in my car, bring into the Pantry, pack into the bags--and I was certainly ready to do it! But then a good friend came in and happened to ask "Could you use some bread?" Could I use some BREAD???? Why yes I could!

She connected me with a new Pastor in the area, Pastor Roger from Trinity Lutheran in Amsterdam and he pulled up in a pickup truck FULL of bread! How fun is that? A pickup truck full of bread from the Amen Soup Kitchen in Amsterdam. Pastor Roger and I had the opportunity to meet and unpack all that bread (oh thank you for those grocery carts at the Pantry!!!) Look at his smiling face behind all that bread! I got to put a loaf in every bag we are giving away tomorrow, plus there's more for our regular guests who will be visiting us on Saturday.



THEN (oh yeah, this keeps going) a car pulls up next to Pastor Roger's truck with the two people from the Amen Soup Kitchen--the same people who gave him the bread originally, but they had NO idea where he was bringing it! 





